

Educational Drum Clinic Topics By Yoseph "Joe" Levy

<u>It all starts here:</u> Discussion on proper grip of drumsticks. Traditional verses matched. Explain the fulcrum point. Finger control technique. Wrist action . Sticking heights. Moeller technique etc.

<u>Drum rudiment talk:</u> The building blocks to allow a drummer real freedom of expression. Application on snare & drums. Right leads & Left leads. The (3) basic roll forms. Combine singles with doubles.

<u>Rhythmic notation:</u> Basic knowledge of music notation in order to understand your rhythms. Notes & rests. Time signatures & their meaning & importance. Time = the difference between rhythm & noise.

Look Mum I can play with both my two hands & two feet: Play simultaneously & independently of all four limbs. Add your foot hi-hat & hear the difference. Maximize this potential.

<u>The lost art of brushes:</u> Basic sweeps & strokes using brushes. Sweep in time rather than strike in time. How to play strokes with brushes. The mindset to this form of playing. How it'll help with your dynamics.

Express yourself: Some tips on sounding musical with your drumming.

Experiment with the sounds of your drums & add some new ones. Don't be afraid to improvise over standard rhythms. Different sticks/mallets/brushes give off different sounds. Use them creatively.
